

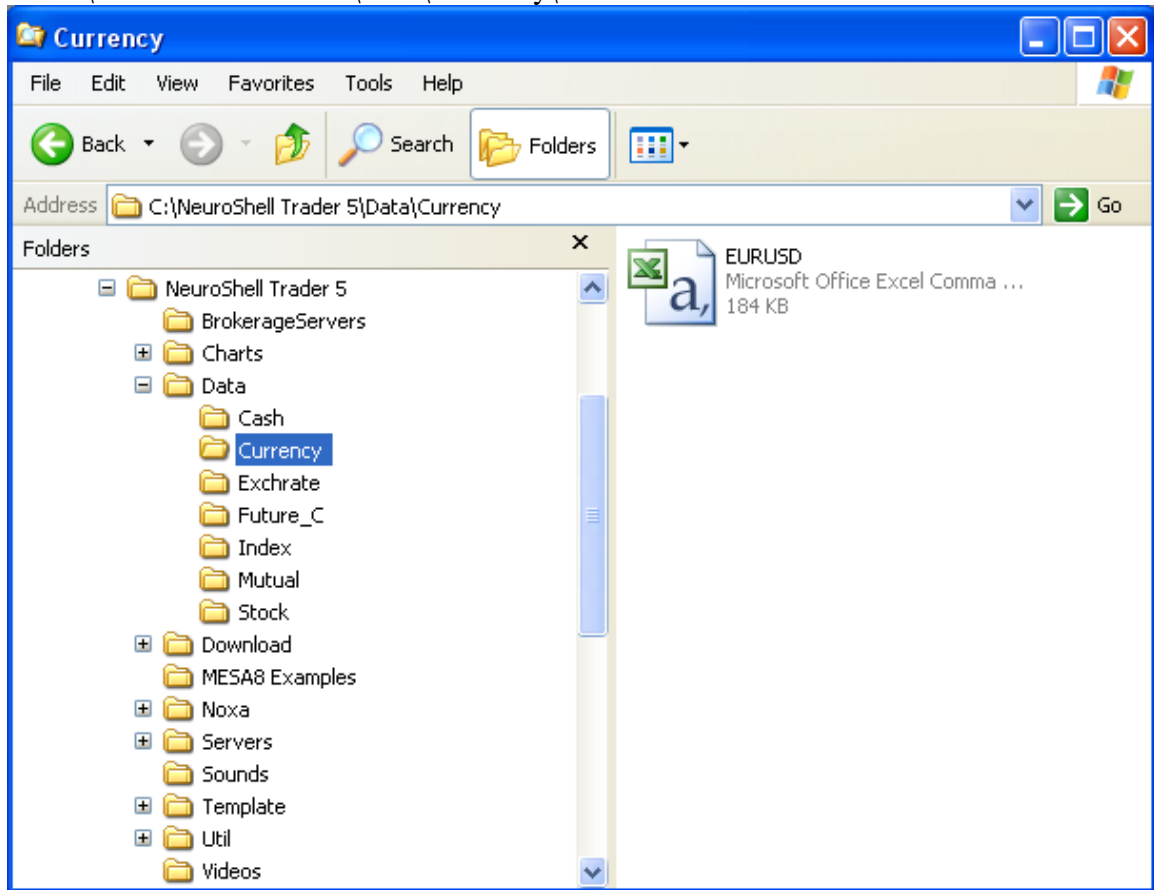

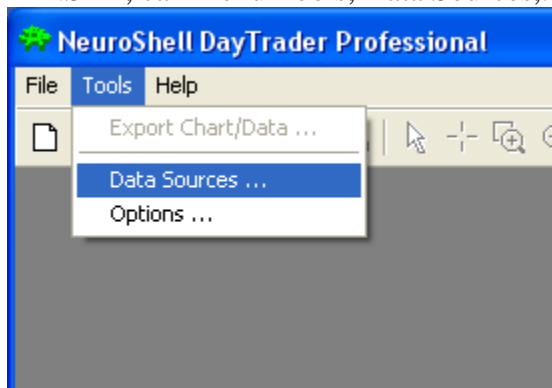

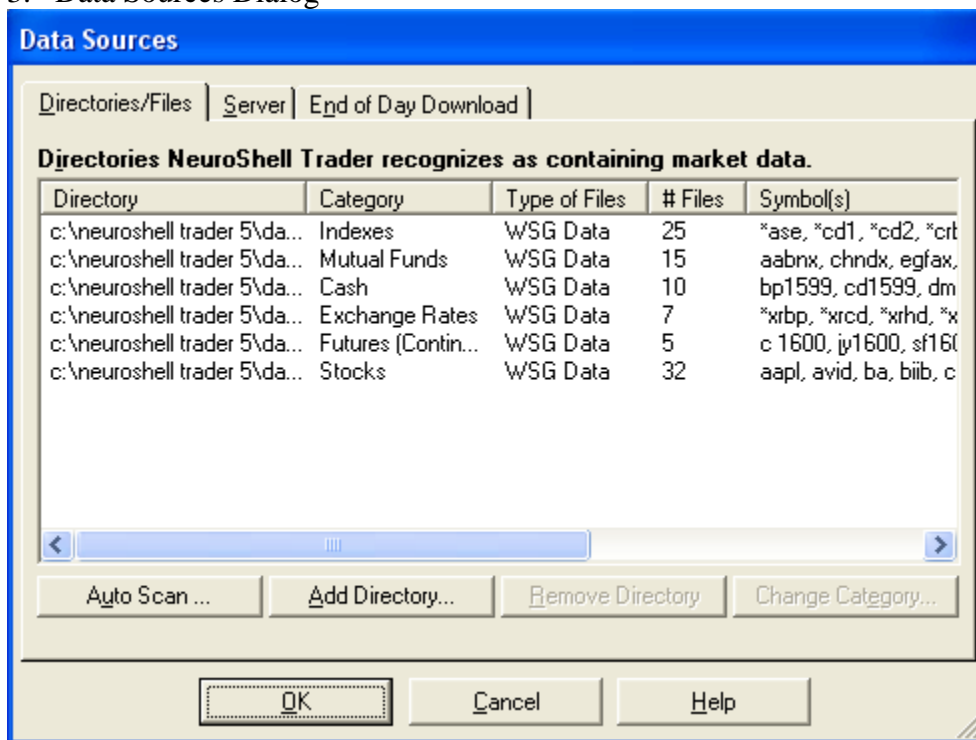
1. Copy the file into a folder, example I put in this folder  
C:\Neuroshell Trader 5\Data\Currency\



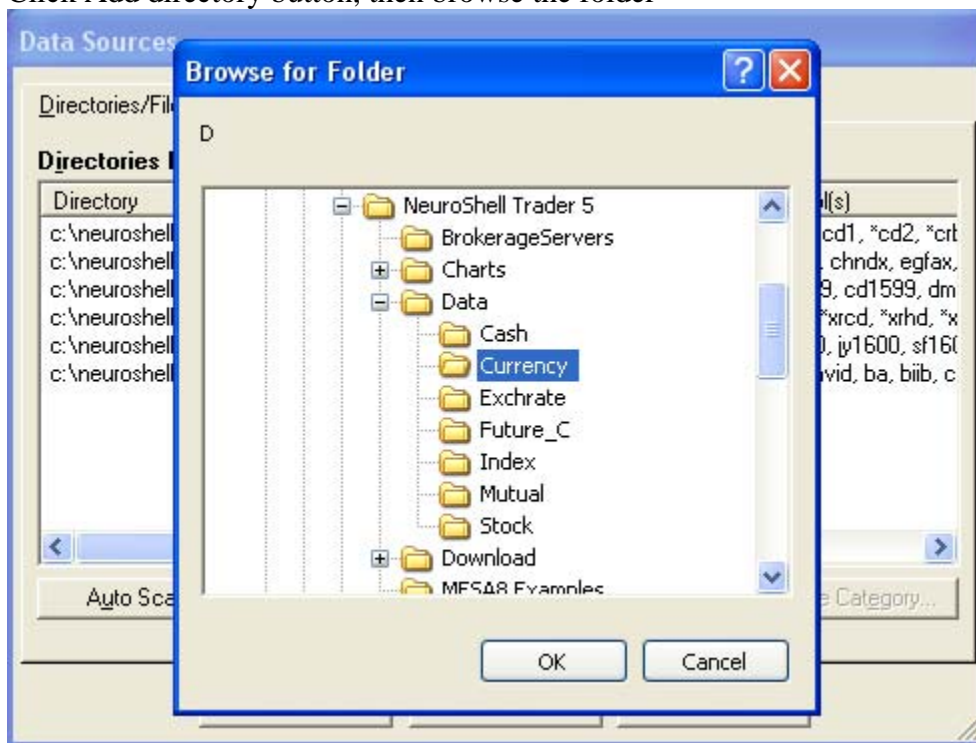
2. In NSDT, call menu Tools, Data Sources,...



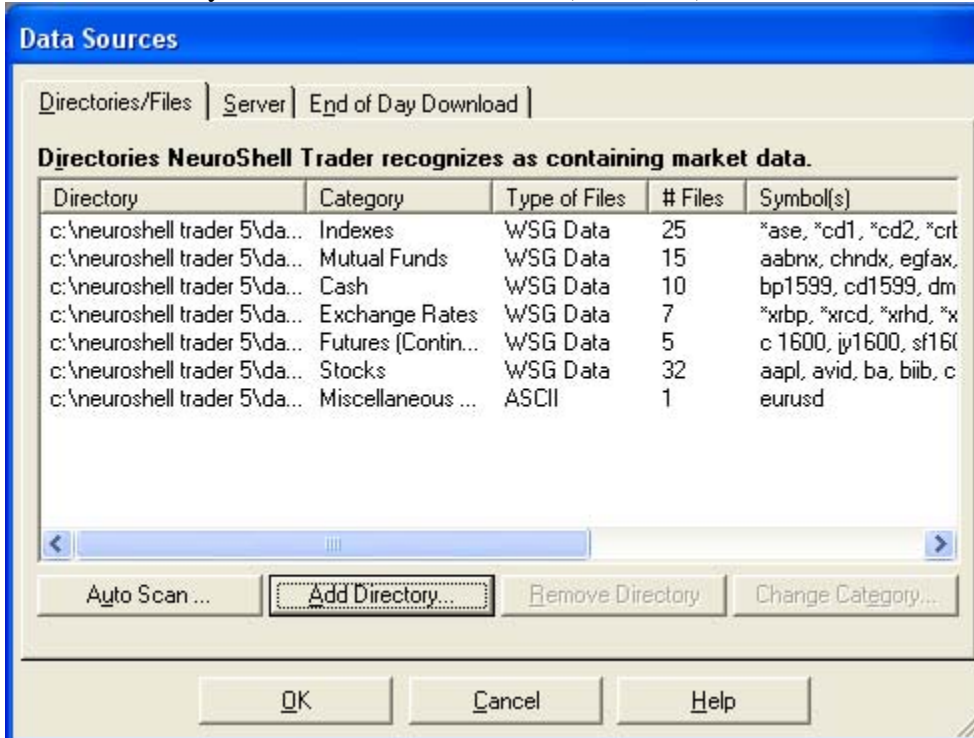
### 3. Data Sources Dialog



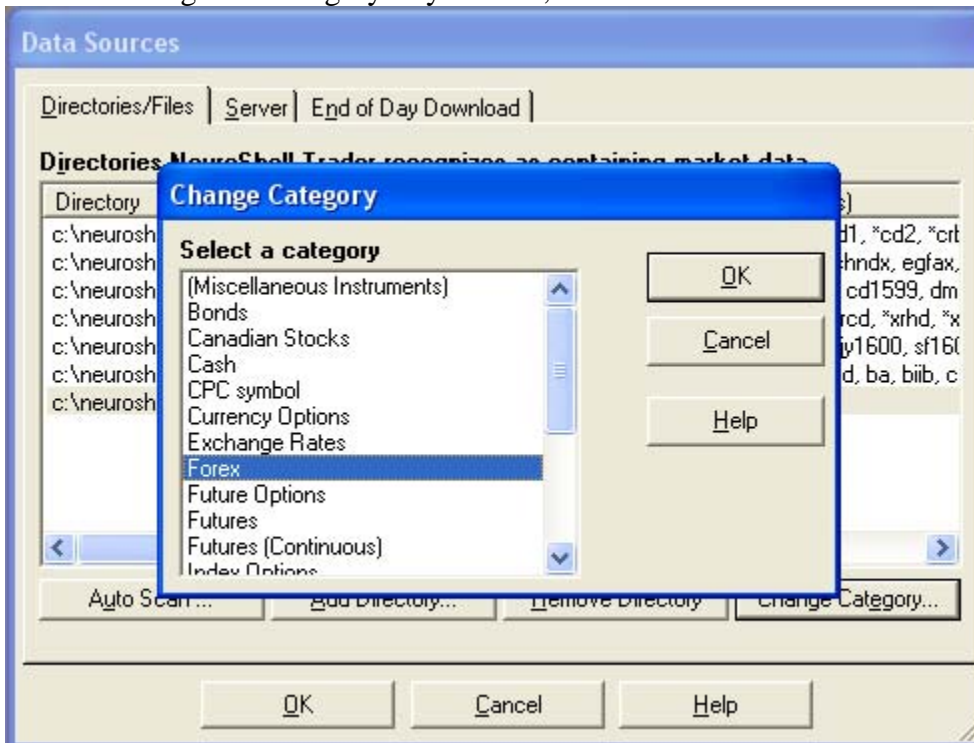
Click Add directory button, then browse the folder



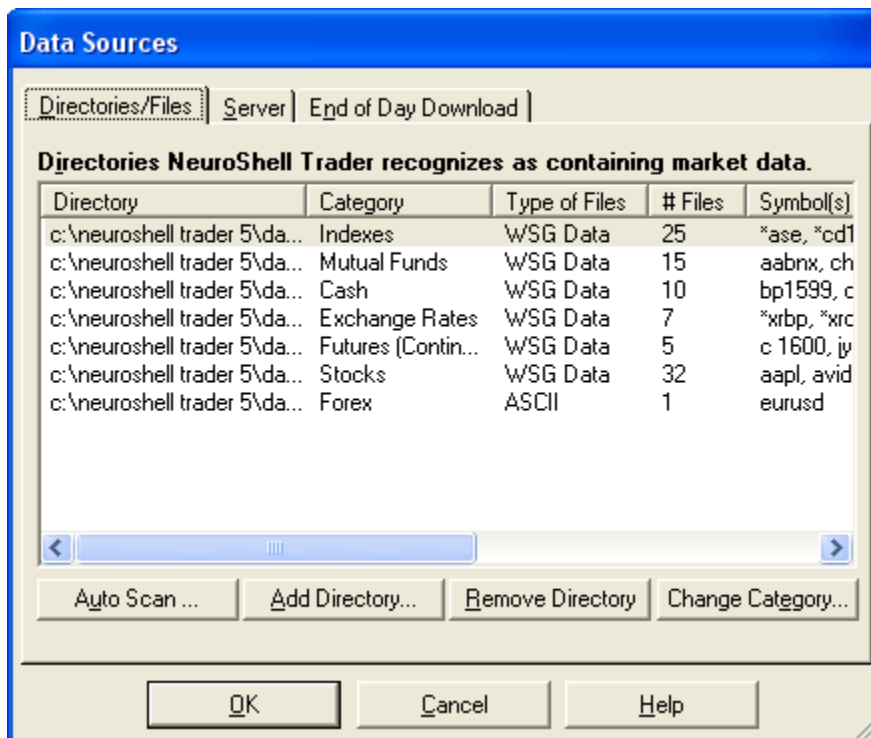
Click OK, then you will see the new folder (at bottom) is on the list.



You can change the Category as you wish, here I use the saved file as forex category



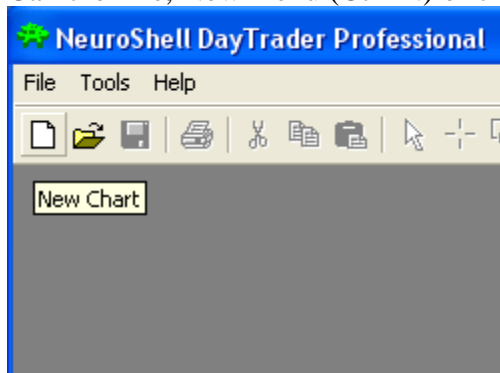
Click Ok, you will see as below



Click OK to finish

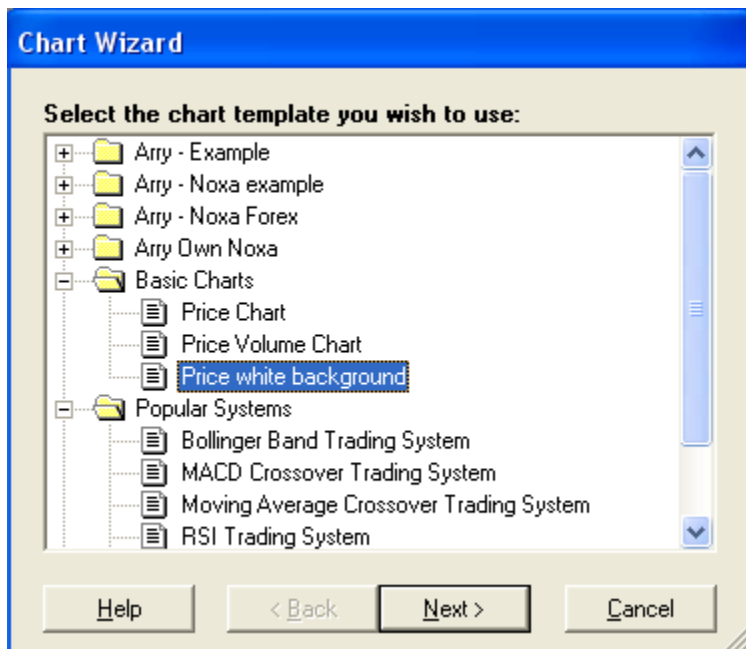
#### 4. Displaying data into the chart on NSDT

Call the File, New menu (Ctrl-N) or click the button

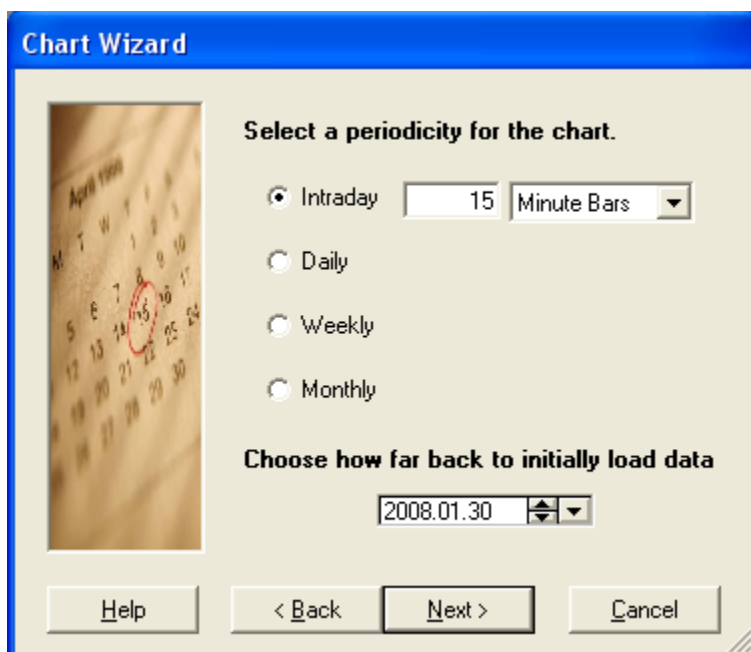


Follow the Chart wizard dialog:

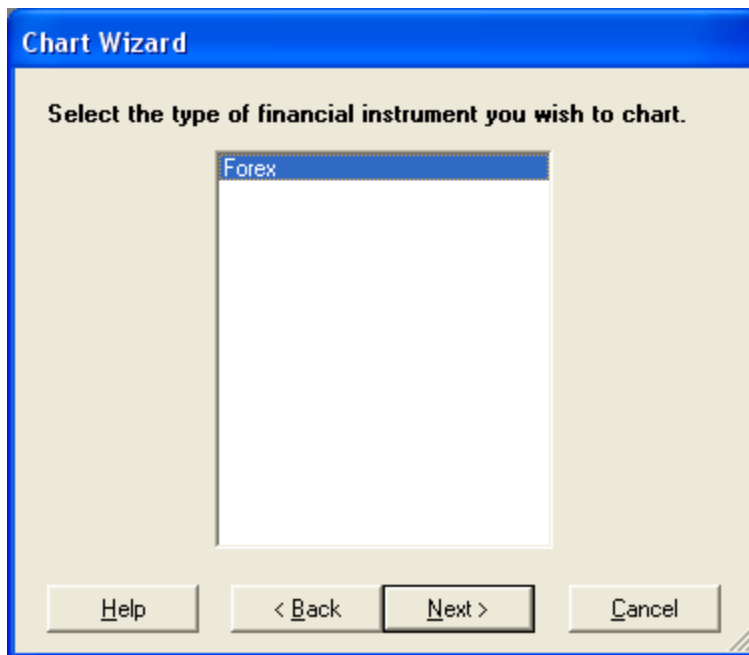
- a. Select the chart template (every one can choose his own available template), here I have Price white background to display the price only.



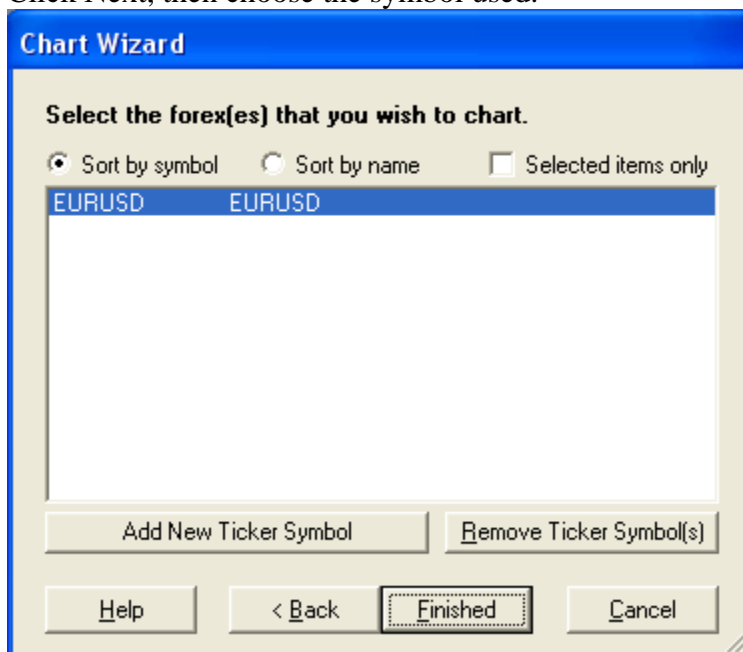
Click next button, change the intraday period data, here I use 15m data and start from 2008.01.30
